

## 2009 Touch Wine Insurance Procedure

All participants will be covered under Touch Football Australia's insurance policy (through World Wide Sports Insurance) providing the following steps are adhered to by all participants.

- 1) All individual participants are required to complete all sections, sign and return the Individual Registration form to TFSA before COB Friday 6<sup>th</sup> of November 2009. Forms available at [http://www.touchwine.com.au/dev/?page\\_id=8](http://www.touchwine.com.au/dev/?page_id=8) (Late forms will be received at the discretion of TFSA prior to the event. If no form is received or is not signed you are not covered and will be prohibited from participating)
- 2) Team Contacts must complete and submit the TFA Team Registration Form to TFSA before COB Friday 6<sup>th</sup> of November. Forms available at [http://www.touchwine.com.au/dev/?page\\_id=8](http://www.touchwine.com.au/dev/?page_id=8)
- 3) ALL PLAYERS MUST sign in at tournament control prior to their first match of the day regardless if you have already signed your individual registration form.(this will cover all games played on the day)
- 4) If injured, the injured person or a fellow team member must notify the match referee to record the incident on the score sheet; AND/OR

The injured person or team member must report the incident to TFSA tournament control immediately after the incident or game

Touch Football SA staff will then advise on the injury claims procedure and assist where possible (Please note all claims must be lodged within 30 days of the incident)
